A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW
DECLARING THE RESULT OF THE CANVASS OF RETURNS OF THE
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018
FOR THE ELECTION OF THREE MEMBERS TO THE CITY COUNCIL
AND FOR BALLOT MEASURE P (BUSINESS LICENSE TAX)
AND BALLOT MEASURE Q (CANNABIS TAX)

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, to elect three members to the City Council and submit to the voters an ordinance relating to a Business License Tax (Measure P) and an ordinance related to a Cannabis Tax (Measure Q); and

WHEREAS, the Registrar of Voters of the County of Santa Clara canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results in accordance with the appropriate provisions of the California Elections Code (Exhibit A);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Mountain View as follows:

1. That the total number of ballots cast in the City of Mountain View was 28,566 and that a full and correct copy of the statement of results of said election for three Council seats and for Measures P and Q were canvassed and certified by the County Registrar of Voters, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

2. That at said election, Lucas Ramirez, Ellen Kamei, and Alison Hicks received the highest number of votes for the three Council seats for full four-year terms and have been declared as elected as Councilmembers:

3. That as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on Measure P— Business License Tax, voted in favor of it and that the measure was carried and shall be deemed adopted and ratified:

Measure P – Business License Tax

Shall the measure to fund critical City needs such as reducing traffic congestion, enhancing bicycle/pedestrian-friendly routes, providing housing affordable for a range of incomes/homeless services, by imposing a business license tax of between \$8 and \$149 per employee on average, with larger companies paying more per employee, generating about \$6 million yearly for unrestricted general revenue purposes, until ended by voters, with independent yearly audits, be adopted?

4. That as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on Measure Q—Cannabis Tax, voted in favor of it and that the measure was carried and shall be deemed adopted and ratified:

Measure Q – Cannabis Tax

Shall the measure to maintain and protect essential public safety services, including 9-1-1, police and fire protection, emergency medical response; reduce traffic congestion and repair roads; and provide other critical City services, including library, park maintenance, senior services, by levying a tax of up to 9 percent on gross receipts of cannabis businesses, providing about 1 million dollars per year, for unrestricted general revenue purposes, until ended by voters, with independent yearly audits, be adopted?
