Grants



- December 2023: Awarded \$25k from County to provide climate resiliency support to vulnerable communities
- March 2024: Finalist for Strategic Growth Council resiliency grant (~\$5M) submitted last year not awarded.
- March 2024: Applied for \$14.3M from the EPA to upgrade 2 city/school district gyms with resiliency measures
- April 2024: Approximately \$2M California Energy Commission grant application in progress for City fleet charging, requires matching funds
- **April 2024:** Applying for \$148K in Department of Energy funding to electrify city operations

- Income-qualified E-Bike Voucher Program accepting applications April 8-28
 - www.mountainview.gov/e-bikes
- BlocPower available to multifamily property owners
 - Developing public-facing website and internal map to inform outreach
 - BlocPower is already working with two properties, and official program launch anticipated this quarter
- PG&E program to replace water heaters at City facilities at low or no cost
- Cool Block hiring for a part time position to launch 2024 cohort
