6.3 RENGSTORFF AQUATICS CENTER, CIP PROJECT 18-38

Staff provided an update on the project. Staff will recommend stabilization of 12 original fish sculptures from the existing facility to be displayed in the new facility. Staff presented renderings of the proposed locations of the fish sculptures and proposed locations of the wave bench, water drop sculptures, and lenticular circles.

The Committee requested information about the restoration process for the fish sculptures and recommended that an informational plaque be placed on-site that notes that the fish sculptures were a part of the original building.

6.4 FAYETTE PARK, CIP PROJECT 20-48, ART PROPOSAL SELECTION

Staff provided additional information on the three top-ranked proposals, including technical considerations and revised proposals. The Committee discussed the revised proposals.

Motion – M/S Merhar/Cupp – Carried 5-0-2; Sakols, Whitebread absent – To approve the following recommendation to be considered by the City Council for Fayette Park:

1. Two to three biomorphic, climbable animal sculptures from Colin Selig, with the final animals and colors to be chosen by the artist, excluding green, for a 2% public art budget; and

2. One to two biomorphic, climbable animal sculptures from Colin Selig, with the final animals and colors to be chosen by the artist, excluding green, for a 1% public art budget.
