- 2. A Resolution Recommending that the City Council Approve a General Plan Map Amendment for the Properties Located at 777 West Middlefield Road from Medium-Density Residential to High-Density Residential;
- 3. A Resolution Recommending that the City Council Approve a Zoning Map Amendment for the Properties Located at 777 West Middlefield Road from R3-2 (Multiple-Family Residential) District to P (Planned Community) District;
- 4. A Resolution Recommending that the City Council Conditionally Approve a Planned Community Permit and Development Review Permit to Construct a 716-Unit Apartment Project and a Heritage Tree Removal Permit to Remove 127 Heritage Trees at 777 West Middlefield Road (see Exhibit 4); and

5. A Resolution Recommending that the City Council Conditionally Approve a Vesting Preliminary Parcel Map to Subdivide One Lot into Two Lots Located at 777 West Middlefield Road to Create Two Lots.
