




Mountain View Bike Share Survey

 - 18 reported they had not tried the program




TYPICAL MODES USED TO GET AROUND


DO YOU EVER RIDE A BICYCLE IN MOUTAIN VIEW TO DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING?





FAMILIARITY WITH BIKE SHARE PROGRAMS






PERCEPTION OF DOCKLESS BIKE SHARE IN MOUNTAIN VIEW













Key System Functioning Finding

THERE WERE TOO FEW BIKES NEAR ME WHEN I NEEDED ONE










Key Barriers and Externalities Finding

THERE AREN'T ENOUGH BIKE TRAILS OR PROTECTED BIKE LANES WHERE I WANT TO GO











PARTICIPANTS VS NON-PARTICIPANTS: THE BIKE SHARE PROGRAM HELPED REDUCE CAR TRAFFIC







Key Findings

- People who used bike share in Mountain View see it as a useful way to get around and think it provides multiple benefits
- Opinions of bike share were split between people who did not try it, and less favorable than those who did try it
- There is broad demand for more trails and protected bike lanes
- The bike share parking requirements were generally clear, but less so in Downtown Mountain View
- People were using bike share to replace car trips and frequently to connect with transit
