## **RECOMMENDATION**

Adopt an Ordinance of the City of Mountain View Authorizing an Amendment to the Contract Between the City Council of the City of Mountain View and the Board of Administration of the California Public Employees' Retirement System, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 1 to the Council report). (First reading: 7-0)

## **SUMMARY**

On September 12, 2023, the City Council approved a Resolution of Intention and introduced an ordinance to amend the contract for all unrepresented safety Public Employees' Pension Reform Act (PEPRA) employees between the Board of Administration, California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS), and the City Council of the City of Mountain View. This amendment will maintain the total contribution employees pay for their pension benefit as set forth in Council resolutions for Unrepresented Safety Employees by decreasing the cost-share amounts paid by all unrepresented safety PEPRA employees by 0.75% to offset an increase of 0.75% in their normal employee contribution.

The Council approved the resolution and ordinance by a 7-0 vote. This is a second reading of the ordinance for the CalPERS Contract Amendment (Attachment 1).

**FISCAL IMPACT**—There is no fiscal impact associated with this ordinance.
