Subcommittee Scope

• Purpose

Help identify opportunities to engage the public and provide input on the analysis of RIPA data

Focus

- Gain from "line level," supervisory and data analyst's perspectives to further the Subcommittees ability to make effective recommendations to the PSAB.
- Review existing RIPA data
- Explore ways to make MVPD data open and available to the public
- Advise MVPD on ways to partner with the community to determine additional data sharing that may be useful in the future

Approach and Timeline

- Gather information about RIPA data/process- to include collection, submission and data itself (est. Summer 2022)
- Engage with community and solicit feedback for RIPA transparency / accessibility (est. Fall 2022)
- Propose recommended RIPA data practices to PSAB (Winter 2022)



Status of Work To-Date

- Subcommittee met three times (March, April, May)
- Gained understanding of RIPA requirements and process from user level, supervisor and data analyst perspectives
- Examined the first data submission





- Set up shared drive to coordinate subcommittee work
- Identify community groups / key stakeholders
- Draft interview questions for key stakeholders
- Schedule and conduct conversations with key stakeholders
- Continue data review
- Propose recommended RIPA data practices to PSAB
