SUBJECT: Recycling Center Building Retrofit, Project 20-18 Bid Relief Request and

Documentation per Public Contract Code 5101 (b)

On October 27, 2022, the City Clerk's Office received four bids for the Recycling Center Building Retrofit Project ranging from \$697,050 to \$1,155,000. The lowest bid was submitted by EVRA Construction, Inc.

On October 28, 2022, one business day after the bid opening, EVRA Construction, Inc. submitted a request to withdraw their bid due to an inadvertent clerical mistake in their bid (Exhibit A). Sections 5101 to 5103 in Division 2, Part 1 "Administrative Provisions" of the California Public Contract Code (CPPC) allows a bidder to request their bid be relieved without forfeiture of their bid security when a clerical error is made when filling out the bid. Section 5103 entitles a bidder to relief when the bidder demonstrates the following: (a) a mistake was made, (b) written notice was provided within five working days after bid opening specifying in the notice in detail how mistake occurred, (c) the mistake made the bid materially different than intended, and (d) the mistake was made out in filling out the bid and not due to an error in judgement or to carelessness in inspecting the site of the work, or in reading the plans and specifications.

EVRA Construction, Inc. provided a letter of explanation (Exhibit A). The bid tabulation submitted with the bid relief request showed pricing for General Conditions, Bond, Project Manager, Overhead Profit and Allowance that were inadvertently excluded from the Base Bid Amount on their submitted Schedule of Values (SOV). The bid tabulation sheet also highlighted several other discrepancies resulting in a wide range of changes from small to large to many other bid items on their SOV which if included would have added approximately \$142,000 more to their base bid. After requests by staff to provide more details on how their bid was calculated, EVRA submitted a "corrected" SOV based on their internal bid tabulation sheet (Exhibit B). The revised SOV indicated that EVRA did not transfer costs for multiple large elements of the work including handrails, asphaltic concrete paving, rooftop supports & equipment screens, and other smaller

elements to the bid forms. The cumulative impact of EVRA's failure to include values for these elements of the work was another material error in preparing their bid.

EVRA Construction, Inc. characterizes each of the errors as a "clerical error in calculating the bid amount". Staff agrees this was a clerical error due to transcription rather than an error in judgement and that the bidder should be allowed to withdraw their bid. EVRA Construction demonstrated a good faith effort with the timeliness provisions of Section 5103 by regularly and clearly communicating with staff regarding the details of the bid irregularity. Given this good faith effort, the cumulative magnitude of the errors, and demonstrating compliance with section 5103, staff recommends their request for bid relief be granted.
