Anyone wishing to address the Advisory Board should make their interest known to the Chair. Speakers are allowed to speak for up to three minutes. If there appears to be a large number of speakers, speaking time may be reduced to no less than 1.5 minutes.

If requested in advance of the public input portion of the agenda item to the Chair or staff, a speaker who represents five or more members of the public in attendance but elect not to speak may have up to 10 minutes to address the Advisory Board, if the Chair determines that such extension will reduce the total number of speakers who planned to speak.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 54954.3(b)(1), at least twice the allotted speaking time will be provided to a member of the public who utilizes a translator.
