TITLE: **Posting of Political Signs**

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution Rescinding Resolution No. 17316 and Adopting a Revised Resolution Designating Public Properties Upon Which Political Signs May Be Posted, to be read in title only, further reading waived.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

The Mountain View City Code requires the City Council to designate by resolution those public properties upon which political signs may be placed. From time to time, the City Council revises the resolution to update the list of sites to reflect changes in ownership or use of City-owned property. These sites were used for the June primary election and will also be posted for the November election. The resolution was last revised in 2008. Should the Council be interested in adding or deleting any sites to the revised list, the resolution can be modified accordingly.

Once approved, copies of the attached resolution (Attachment 1) and an informational letter explaining the Political Sign Ordinance and describing appropriate locations accompanied by photographs of approved locations will be included in the nomination packets provided to prospective candidates.

The proposed resolution reflects a street name change on one of the sites listed in the 2008 resolution. The City right-of-way at the northeast corner formerly known as Grant Road and Levin Avenue needs to be updated because it is now Grant Road and April Lane.

FISCAL IMPACT – None.

CONCLUSION

Staff recommends that the resolution be revised to accurately reflect City-owned sites where political signs may be posted.

ALTERNATIVE

Modify the proposed resolution to add or delete locations.
