TITLE: **Appointment to the Los Altos School District Site Advisory Task Force**

RECOMMENDATION

Appoint a current member of the Mountain View City Council (or another representative) to the Los Altos School District Site Advisory Task Force.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

At its meeting of January 16, 2018, the City Council approved various actions related to the development of a new school and open space in the San Antonio Precise Plan area for the Los Altos School District. As part of its action, the City Council expressed a preference that the school at this site be open to north of El Camino Real students and that the School District present a transparent public process to be used in determining the service area of the school and the City's role prior to executing the funding agreement and master agreement for maintenance of fields. The City Council also requested that the school district include a City representative on the task force that will be created as part of their public process.

At its meeting of February 12, 2018, the Los Altos School District Board of Trustees approved formation of a Site Advisory Task Force comprised of stakeholders of the Los Altos School District and City of Mountain View communities. This group is tasked to come together to understand and analyze various issues and factors that must be considered to determine how the School District can best use the 10th site.

Attached is a letter received from Jeffrey Baier, Los Altos School District Superintendent, that includes a copy of the Los Altos School District Site Advisory Task Force proposal. Section II.A. identifies the various stakeholders to be appointed, including one (1) current member of the Mountain View City Council (or appointee). The Los Altos School District is in the process of establishing the Site Advisory Task Force and is requesting the name of the City Council's representative.

As noted on January 16, staff will return with more information on the LASD outreach process concurrent with consideration of a funding agreement for Parkland Fees.

FISCAL IMPACT – None.
