Briefly describe the qualifications you possess (such as employment or community experiences and education) which you feel would be an asset to a board/commission/committee.

I have lived in Mountain View for over 50 years and have had broad work and volunteer experience both in the City and beyond. My education and career experience includes:

An M.A. in Counseling from Stanford University.

After graduate school, I was hired as a Dean for undergraduate students at Stanford and then at UCSC (5 years). Then I worked for the State as an Employment Counselor for 10 years, helping primarily low income people in our area find training and employment. While with the State I ran the summer employment program for youth in Mountain View that was located in the MV Chamber of Commerce.

I left State employment to work for a young nonprofit in Palo Alto, The Career Action Center. Over the next number of years we became the largest nonprofit career center in the U.S. with up to 10,000 members serving both individuals and many of the major high tech companies in our area. I was Program Director and gained lots of experience in human resources, organizational development and strategic planning.

I left to return to Stanford for six years to direct a new program the University was undertaking to attract alumni of color and women leaders back into the University to serve on high level committees and provide broader representation.

All during the years I was working I was involved in the community in many ways, some of the experiences involved sitting on boards

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and committees which I will describe in the next section, but there were many additional ways. For example, I and another woman volunteered to help with the EIR study for North Bayshore that involved interviewing all the residents of that area prior to building Shoreline Park. I was also very involved with the initial downtown revitalization project and worked a lot on housing issues that were involved with the new library and police station.

Another experience I had in working with the City was when my husband and I were buying a house in downtown Mountain View that was redlined by local banks. We reached out to the City Council. They were very responsive and wrote letters to all the banks in Mountain View regarding the issue and helped to resolve issues.

I have always been active on school committees and projects - from trying to get safer crossings for Castro School to writing a grant to build a new music building at MVHS.

Finally in terms of what I would bring to the Advisory Board, my experience in living in 3 different City neighborhoods gives me a perspective that I think would be valuable. We first lived in the Monta Loma neighborhood (5 years), the East of Shoreline (30 years), and now in the [REDACTED] area.




