TITLE: Firearm Safety Ordinances

(Second Reading)

# **RECOMMENDATION**

1. Adopt an Ordinance of the City of Mountain View Amending Chapter 18 of the Mountain View City Code to Add Article II "Firearm Dealers" to Impose Local Permit Requirements on Firearm Dealers Operating Within the City of Mountain View, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 1 to the Council report). (First reading: 6 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent)

2. Adopt an Ordinance of the City of Mountain View Amending Chapter 36, Zoning, of the Mountain View City Code to Add Firearms and Ammunition Retailing as a Prohibited Home Occupation Use, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 2 to the Council report). (First reading: 6 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent)

### **SUMMARY**

On September 12, 2023, the City Council introduced two ordinances that do the following:

- Require firearm dealers to obtain an annual permit from the Mountain View Police Department (MVPD);
- Impose locational restrictions on firearm dealers:
  - 250 feet from schools, daycares, and parks; and
  - Compliance with applicable zoning regulations; and
- Prohibit firearm dealers from operating as home occupations (Attachments 1 and 2).

This is a second reading of the ordinances. If adopted, the ordinances become effective on October 26. Existing firearm dealers would be required to apply for a permit with MVPD by

January 24, 2024. Any firearm dealers operating as home occupations would be required to cease operation one year after the effective date, October 26, 2024.

If adopted, staff will send special notices to all existing firearm dealer businesses to inform them of the requirements for compliance with the ordinances.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

Fiscal impacts will be limited to staff time required for preparation, investigation, and processing of applications, enforcement, and prosecution.

#### <u>ALTERNATIVES</u>

- 1. Do not adopt the ordinances.
- 2. Provide other direction.

## **PUBLIC NOTICING**

Agenda posting and a special notice was sent directly to existing firearm dealers in the City. The ordinance was published at least two days prior to adoption in accordance with City Charter Section 522.
