As the Staff report states, the provisions of the amendments to the Tenant Relocation Assistance Ordinance (TRAO) mirror the TRAO for tenants covered by CSFRA. The LWV has consistently supported CSFRA and TRAO in past years. We supported the Mobile Home Rent Stabilization Ordinance adopted last September. Therefore, we support extending TRAO to the tenants in mobile homes. We are pleased that both the EPC and RHC have reviewed these amendments and recommend them.
