A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT AGREEMENT NO. F026 TO THE ADMINISTERING AGENCY-STATE AGREEMENT FOR FEDERAL-AID PROJECTS— AGREEMENT NO. 04-5124F15 WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR WEST MIDDLEFIELD ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, FROM RENGSTORFF AVENUE TO SHORELINE BOULEVARD, PROJECT 19-35

WHEREAS, the City of Mountain View, a California charter city (CITY), is eligible to receive Federal and/or State funding for certain transportation projects through the California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS); and

WHEREAS, the funding for these transportation projects is administered pursuant to an Administering Agency-State Agreement for Federal Projects – Agreement No. 04-5124F15 (MASTER AGREEMENT) between CITY and the State of California, acting by and through CALTRANS, that established terms and conditions applicable to CITY when receiving Federal funds for a designated project and the subsequent operation and maintenance of that completed project, executed on April 14, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Program Supplement No. F026 (PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT) to the MASTER AGREEMENT is required to be executed for the project identified as “West Middlefield Road Improvements, from Rengstorff Avenue to Shoreline Boulevard, Federal Number STPL-5124(035),” which includes, but is not limited to, retrofitting median island curb, reinstalling concrete cap within existing median island, removing and replacing asphalt concrete pavement, replacing storm drain inlet grate with new bicycle-friendly grates, reinstalling traffic signal loops, and installing pavement marking and markers, identified by CITY as “West Middlefield Road Improvements, from Rengstorff Avenue to Shoreline Boulevard, Project 19-35” (PROJECT), before the SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (STP) funds can be claimed by CITY; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT require a resolution to be adopted by the City Council designating the official authorized to execute the PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of CITY wishes to delegate authorization to execute the PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT to the City Manager of CITY;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Manager of the City of Mountain View is authorized to execute PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT AGREEMENT NO. F026 to MASTER AGREEMENT for PROJECT, and any amendments thereto with CALTRANS.
