Hello,

I would like the BPAC to consider adding bicycle lanes in the street on Wright Avenue between Shoreline and Granada Drive. This is a major corridor for kids riding to and from Stevenson and Theurkauf school. The bike path from downtown on Shoreline stops at Wright Ave and once the kids cross Shoreline to Wright, they are no longer protected by bicycle lane markings in the street. The parked cars along the street push the kids out further into traffic or they ride on the sidewalk.

Wright is a major feeder to downtown but there is no dedicated bike lane striping in the street.

Please consider for the safety of the school kids to add bicycle lanes in the street on Wright Avenue between Shoreline and Granada Drive
