

**Comparison: School Buffer Requirements by State**

<b>State*</b>	<b>Buffer Radius (in feet)</b>	<b>Buffer Subject</b>
<b>Alaska</b>	500	School (preschool through high school), recreation or youth center, building with religious services regularly conducted, correctional facility
<b>California</b>	600	School (preschool through high school), childcare center, daycare center
<b>Colorado</b>	1000	School (preschool through university), seminary, residential child care facility, alcohol and treatment facility
<b>Maine</b>	500	School (kindergarten through high school)
<b>Massachusetts</b>	500	School (kindergarten through high school)
<b>Nevada</b>	1000	School (preschool through high school)
	300	Community facility
<b>Oregon</b>	1000	School (kindergarten through high school)
	500	Buffer may be decreased if there exists a physical or geographic barrier capable of preventing children from traversing to the cannabis retailer
<b>Vermont</b>	500	School (kindergarten through high school), vocational school
<b>Washington</b>	1000	School (kindergarten through high school), playground, recreation center, child care center, public park, public transit center, library, game arcade (where admission is not restricted to ages 21+)
	100	Local jurisdictions can reduce buffer for private playground, recreation center, child care center, public transit center, library, or game arcade
