TITLE: **Green Bike Lane Pilot Project, Project 15-48 – Accept Construction**

RECOMMENDATION

Accept Green Bike Lane Pilot Project, Project 15-48, and authorize the final contract payment.

BACKGROUND

On January 12, 2016, the City Council approved plans and specifications for the Green Bike Lane Project, Project 15-48, and authorized the City Manager to award the construction contract if the low bid was within the project budget. The construction contract was awarded to D&M Traffic Services, Inc., of Santa Clara, California, at the low bid price of \$102,916, which included a \$16,000 construction contingency. The project restriped traffic lanes and installed new traffic signal loops and green bike lanes at the intersections of El Camino Real and Sylvan Avenue/The Americana, Cuesta Drive and Miramonte Avenue, and Grant Road and Bryant Avenue.

ANALYSIS

The construction contract is \$102,916, including a \$16,000 construction contingency. The final construction cost is approximately \$79,300 after a change order that resulted in \$1,116 in contract savings and \$6,500 of liquidated damages assessed to the contractor. All work has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Green Bike Lane Pilot Project, Project 15-48, is funded with a Google contribution of \$65,000 and \$96,000 from the Construction/Conveyance Tax Fund, for a total budget of \$161,000. The total project expenditure is approximately \$125,000. The remaining balance will be returned to the Construction/Conveyance Tax Fund once the project is closed.

ALTERNATIVES

Determine that the improvements have not been completed in conformance with City standards and decline to accept the improvements until they are completed to the satisfaction of the Council.
