Mountain View High School is excited to promote community, fitness and fun with the 5th Annual Spartan Turkey Trot (www.mvhsturkeytrot.shutterfly.com). This event will take place on Thanksgiving morning, Thursday, November 27, 2014.

Due to the size and nature of the event, the Mountain View Police Department is recommending Mountain View City Council approve closure to the following streets, with “no parking restrictions”, from 6:30am – 11:30am:

- Truman Ave., Bryant Ave., Lubich Dr., Diericx Dr., Franklin Ave.

Although the proposed route does not directly travel down the following streets, the route will restrict vehicle access to them, so they also will be closed from 6:30am – 11:30am.

- Bruckner Cir., Tryna Dr., Brower Av., Ivan Wy., Kern Ct., Belshaw Dr., Ramos Ct., Brook Pl., Arbor Ct., Diericx Ct., Franklin Ct., Redcliff Ct.

The proposed times for the event are 8am – 10:30am, although the majority of activity will be contained on the Mountain View High School track. Only the 5K event, starting at 8:30am, will be on the streets mentioned above.

The City Council will hear this item as part of the Consent Calendar on Tuesday, October 7th at 6:30pm in City Hall Council Chambers, 500 Castro Street. Meeting times are subject to change, please confirm the scheduled start time on the City’s website at www.mountainview.gov prior to the meeting date. You are welcome to share your thoughts with the Council on this issue should you desire.
