TITLE: **Rengstorff Park Tennis Courts Resurfacing, Project 19-26 – Amend Project Budget, Approve Plans and Specifications, and Authorize Bidding**

RECOMMENDATION

1. Appropriate and transfer the remaining balance from the Biennial Tennis Court Resurfacing, Project 17-26, of approximately \$83,000 to Biennial Tennis Court Resurfacing (Rengstorff Park Tennis Courts Resurfacing), Project 19-26. (Five votes required)
2. Approve plans and specifications for Rengstorff Park Tennis Courts Resurfacing, Project 19-26, and authorize staff to advertise the project for bids.
3. Authorize the City Manager to award a construction contract to the lowest responsible bidder if the bid is within the project budget.

BACKGROUND

The City has a biennial project to maintain and resurface City tennis courts to keep the courts free from surface cracks and color fading. The City rotates between parks and typically resurfaces the tennis courts every seven years. The tennis courts at Rengstorff Park were last resurfaced in 2012. There are a total of eight (8) tennis courts at Rengstorff Park with various surface defects and maintenance needs.

ANALYSIS

The project scope includes resurfacing, crack repairing, and restriping all eight (8) tennis courts at Rengstorff Park. The crack repair involves filling existing cracks with a taping system which was used in the tennis court resurfacing project at Cuesta Park in 2017 and has shown favorable results. The taping system is included as an alternate bid item.

In coordination with the Community Services Department and tennis court groups, construction is scheduled to begin in August 2019 and be completed by the end of September 2019.

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), this project has been determined to be categorically exempt under Section 15301 as it involves maintenance of existing facilities with no expansion of existing use.

FISCAL IMPACT

Biennial Tennis Court Resurfacing, Project 19-26, is funded with \$87,000 from the Construction/Conveyance Tax Fund. The tennis court resurfacing and pathway project at Cuesta Park, funded by CIP 17-26, is complete. Staff recommends transferring the remaining balance from Biennial Tennis Courts Resurfacing, Project 17-26, of approximately \$83,000 to Project 19-26 for a total budget of \$170,000 to provide sufficient funds for improvements for all of the courts at Rengstorff Park and possible crack filling repair for the courts.

The total project costs related to design and construction are itemized as follows:
