**TITLE:** **Appointment to Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee**

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Approve the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee recommendation for appointment of Lada Adamic as the City of Mountain View’s representative to the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee for the two-year term beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2024.

### **BACKGROUND**

The Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) advises the VTA Board of Directors on bicycle and pedestrian projects/issues and consists of appointed representatives from each city in Santa Clara County. The appointment term is two years, ending on June 30 of each even-numbered year. The City’s current representative on the VTA BPAC is Lada Adamic, whose term expires on June 30, 2022. There are no restrictions on the number of terms a representative may serve on the VTA BPAC.

As outlined in Article VI—Officers, Section 3, of the City Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee’s (B/PAC’s) bylaws, the City’s designated representative to the VTA BPAC is appointed based on a recommendation by the City B/PAC to the City Council.

### **ANALYSIS**

At its March 30, 2022 meeting, the City B/PAC recommended Lada Adamic to continue to serve as the City’s representative on the VTA BPAC for the two-year term beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2024.

If approved, the appointment recommendation will be forwarded to the VTA Board of Directors for final approval.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

Although there is no direct impact associated with this recommendation, the VTA BPAC makes recommendations regarding various bicycle and pedestrian projects to the VTA Board of Directors for funding consideration.

**ALTERNATIVES**

Approve the appointment of a different City B/PAC member to serve as the City's representative on the VTA BPAC.
