TITLE: **Ordinance Amending Section 19.70.1 of the Mountain View City Code Related to the Parking of Vehicles that Discharge Domestic Sewage on the Public Right-of-Way (Second Reading)**

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt an Ordinance Amending Section 19.70.1 to Chapter 19, Division 2, of the Mountain View City Code Related to the Parking of Vehicles that Discharge Domestic Sewage on the Public Right-of-Way, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 1 to the Council report). (First reading: 6-1, Matichak no)

SUMMARY

On June 11, 2019, the City Council introduced an ordinance to amend Section 19.70.1 of the Mountain View City Code related to the parking of vehicles that discharge domestic sewage on the Public Right-of-Way (PROW) to clarify that vehicles actively discharging, either continuously or intermittently, domestic sewage from a sewage system, sewage tank, holding tank, or other waste storage receptacle, or any pipe associated therewith, onto the PROW would be in violation of the parking regulation.
