Small Business Resiliency Program and Small Landlord Assistance Program Update



- Programs launched April 29
- Application period closed May 1
- Small Business Resiliency Program = **167 inquiries**
- Small Landlord Program = **9 inquiries**
- City-staffed **Small Business Call Center** outreach launching



Safe Parking Lot Update



- Shoreline and Evelyn lots currently open 24/7
- Terra Bella lot will open soon
- Shoreline Lot: 21 vehicles / 48 participants
- Evelyn Lot: 17 vehicles / 33 participants
- Faith-based lot: 4 vehicles / 4 participants
- Public Works staff completed fresh water installation at Shoreline and Evelyn lots

Shelter in Place Order Modifications

Golf

- Shoreline Golf opened yesterday
- Only single players teeing off one at a time

Tennis

- Courts reopened today with social distancing between courts
- Players limited to member of their own household or living unit

Skate Park

- Opened today

Sailing Lake

- Operations not permitted until further analysis of order is completed



Shelter in Place Order Modifications

Construction

- All construction operations resumed with distancing requirements
- Plans and permits being processed

Streets and Utilities Maintenance

- Expanded crews working in the field with distancing requirements

Gardening, Landscaping, Tree Maintenance

- Crews working with staggered start times and 1 person per vehicle
