Recap - Subcommittee Scope

Purpose

 Help inform and raise awareness about new mental health crisis response programs in Mountain View

Focus

- Mental health crisis response programs that provide new or expanded alternatives to police response (Santa Clara County TRUST and MCRT in North County)
- New MVPD approaches to mental health crisis when police response is needed (MVPD Behavioral Services Unit)

Approach and Timeline

- Gathering and sharing information about mental health crisis response needs and resources in Mountain View in time for new program launch (est. Fall 2022)
- Not a comprehensive needs and asset assessment
- Emphasis on crisis response, not entire continuum of mental health services



Status Update - Work Plan

- Identify data needs, information sources and community contacts Complete
- Reach out to community contacts and gather data In Progress
- Monitor development of TRUST, MCRT and MVPD BSU programs In Progress
- Compile information to develop an informal Mountain View "community profile" to help inform County and MVPD programs – In Progress
- Partner with County and TRUST/MCRT providers to share information with the community and promote awareness of these new/expanded programs - In Progress
- Seek community feedback about TRUST and MCRT and share with the County Not started; TRUST to launch around mid-October
- Bring updates and recommendations to the PSAB Not started





- Continued key contact outreach and data gathering
- City staff networking with Momentum for Health, the new TRUST provider
- Human Services Manager joined newly created TRUST Community Advisory Board
- Continued staff meetings with County Behavioral Health re: 988 crisis line, MCRT, etc.





- Conduct conversations with remaining key contacts
- Complete data gathering
- Draft an informal Mountain View "community profile"
- Present profile to PSAB and transmit to the County, Momentum for Health, MVPD, etc.
- Continue networking with Momentum for Health to support building community awareness of TRUST
