I wanted to draw your attention to a discrepancy between the resolution attached to the agenda and what was handed out at yesterday's farmers market. Namely that the calendar given to visitors says Nov 13<sup>th</sup> will be at Caltrain (see attached photo), but the resolution says that all home games, including the 13<sup>th</sup>, will have the farmers market at Bryant.

My further comment is that moving the farmers market is an annoyance, and I wonder if any study has been done of parking lot utilization on game days. How many people are parking to go to the game vs. how many people have the extra overhead of having to check where the market will be? Given that there are other VTA stops that people could drive to, is moving the farmers market worth the hassle? Personally, I have gone to the Caltrain location in error probably half a dozen times over the years because I forget to check the calendar. On at least one or two occasions, after realizing I had come to the wrong place, I gave up on going that day because I only had a limited amount of time for the trip (and I usually walk to the market).
