
City Staff Redeployment to CSA

- **8 City staff** were redeployed last week
- Provided **62 hours** to help:
 - Food Delivery assistance to seniors at their residences
 - Food Distribution assistance onsite at CSA
 - **4 staff** provided translation services in Spanish, Russian, and Chinese
- Redeployment will continue during modified City services



Shower Services for Homeless/Unstably Housed

- Hope's Corner shower service on **Mon-Wed-Fri from 7am-11am**
- Dignity on Wheels mobile shower services every **Tuesday at CSA 1pm-4pm**
- Estimated to provide shower capacity for **more than 80 people**

Countywide Tracking and Tracing Efforts

- County in process of rapidly expanding infrastructure for contact tracing
- Expect to need more than 700 contact tracers to perform work countywide
