## **RECOMMENDATION**

Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Mountain View Appointing 15 Members and 10 Members-at-Large/Alternates to the Youth Advisory Committee for the 2024-25 School Year Term, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 1 to Council report).

## **BACKGROUND**

On September 11, 2007, the City Council approved Resolution No. 17235 establishing the Youth Advisory Committee (YAC) to initiate increased civic involvement by youth in Mountain View. The resolution states that the YAC may consist of a maximum of 15 middle school and high school students and that members are to be selected through an application and interview process facilitated through the Community Services Department, Recreation Division, reviewed by the Council Youth Services Committee (CYSC), and appointed by the City Council.

In spring 2024, Recreation Division staff began YAC recruitment efforts for the 2024-25 school year, as described in Attachment 1. A total of 43 applications were received by the deadline. Applicants were interviewed by Recreation staff in April, and the appointment recommendations were forwarded to the CYSC on May 28, 2024.
