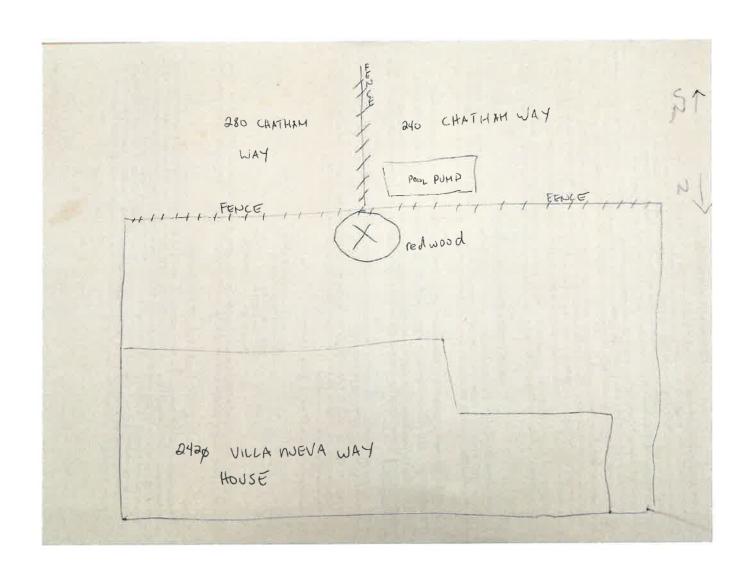

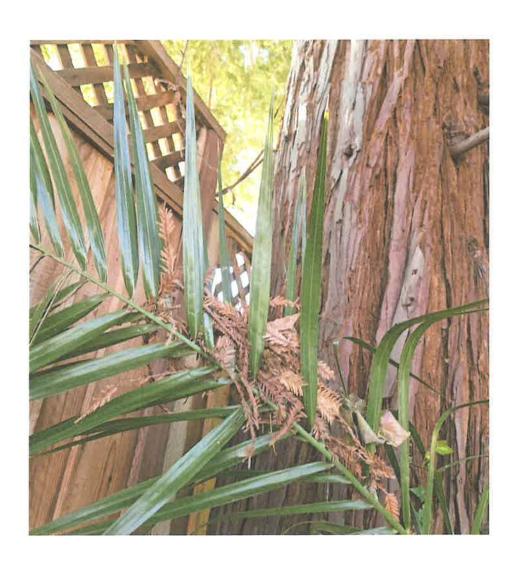

In one of the neighbor's yards, the roots are causing damage by pushing up at their existing concrete/retaining wall and possibly all the way to their pool area. Tree will also likely damage fence soon as it grows.

Regular trimmings are done by me (the property owner). PG&E also does annual trimmings to clear branches from utility lines. I also invited an arborist from Valley Tree care to inspect the tree but we can't find a solution to prevent future damage to the fence and structures without incursion into neighbor's property and expensive and extensive digging.
