Upon the completion of a field inspection, Forestry Division staff has determined that the request to have the tree/trees removed be:

CONDITION OF TREE / CONDITIONS AFFECTING THE TREE: (Tree #2) Tree without signs of decline or drought stress. Submitted plans for new home and driveway do not appear to significantly impact tree. Located 16 inches away from existing driveway but proposed driveway can likely be maintained with only slight modifications to provide additional root space for tree. Sap is not a valid criteria for removal. Tree does not appear to impact utilities on site based on identified location of water and sewer lines on the opposite side of the driveway. Does not meet ordinance criteria for removal.

Any person wishing to appeal this action must file an appeal (Fee \$50) with the City Clerk's Office, 500 Castro Street, Mountain View, CA. The office is open for drop-ins Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Appeals must be submitted by **5:00 p.m., June 2, 2025.**
