A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW  
AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN  
THE SANTA CLARA COUNTY ABANDONED VEHICLE ABATEMENT  
SERVICE AUTHORITY PROGRAM AND EXTENSION OF THE SERVICE FEE

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Sections 9250.7 and 22710 provide for the establishment of a service authority for abandoned vehicle abatement and the imposition of a One Dollar (\$1) surcharge on vehicle registration fees in the County (the fee) if the County Board of Supervisors, and the majority of the cities within the County, adopt resolutions supporting such action; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2011, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 17636 approving the City's continued participation in the Santa Clara County Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Service Authority (AVASA) program and the imposition of the fee; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to applicable law, the imposition of the fee was limited to a period of 10 years and is set to expire on April 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, State law permits the fee to be extended in 10-year increments if the County Board of Supervisors, by a two-thirds vote, and a majority of the cities having a majority of the incorporated population within the County, adopt resolutions providing for the extension of the fee; and

WHEREAS, the City, because of the inherent cost savings, desires to continue participating in the AVASA Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Mountain View:

1. Approves the continued participation in the existing Agreement for the Santa Clara County Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Service Authority program and the collection, by the Department of Motor Vehicles, of a One Dollar (\$1) vehicle registration fee for this purpose.

2. Requests the extension of the Santa Clara County Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Service Authority program for another 10-year term, beginning in May 2022.

3. Authorizes the City Manager's continued participation as a member of the Santa Clara County Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Service Authority and the City Manager's execution, on behalf of the City, of any documents necessary to accomplish the purposes of this resolution.
