SUBJECT: Pedestrian Master Plan – Annual Review

RECOMMENDATION

Review and provide comments regarding the current Pedestrian Master Plan.

BACKGROUND

When the City Council approved revisions to the Pedestrian Master Plan (PMP) at its January 28, 2014 meeting, Council directed the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee (B/PAC) to include an annual review of the PMP in its work plan.

The purpose of this discussion is to provide B/PAC members with an opportunity to:

- Provide general comments on the PMP's adequacy in addressing the pedestrian-related needs of the community.
- Identify topics, issues, and concerns that should be considered for inclusion in a future update of the PMP.

ANALYSIS

Summaries of comments received at past annual reviews are included in Attachment 1.

The B/PAC is requested to review these lists and advise staff of any new issues that may have arisen that should be added to the list.

NEXT STEPS

Staff will maintain a list of items brought up by the B/PAC during the B/PAC's annual review of the PMP to inform the scope, structure, and content of future updates to the PMP.

An update to the PMP is planned as a project for Fiscal Year 2020-21 in the Adopted 2019-20 Capital Improvement Program. On November 10, 2020, Councilmembers recommended that staff consider combining the PMP update with the update of the Bicycle Transportation Plan in order to allow for alignment of competing uses within public rights-of-way for key corridors within the City.
