A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW AUTHORIZING OVERTIME AND PORTAL-TO-PORTAL PAY FOR EMPLOYEES WHEN STAFF ARE DEPLOYED TO ASSIST WITH WILDLAND FIRES AND OTHER EMERGENCY INCIDENTS

WHEREAS, the Mountain View Fire Department is a public agency located in the County of Santa Clara, State of California, and

WHEREAS, it is the State of California's desire to provide fair and legal payment to all its employees for time worked; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mountain View has, in its employ, Fire Department response personnel, including the Fire Chief, Deputy Fire Chief, Battalion Chief, Fire Captain, Fire Engineer, Firefighter/Paramedic, Firefighter/EMT, Office of Emergency Services Coordinator, Emergency Communications Manager, Public Safety Dispatch Coordinator, Public Safety Dispatcher I/II/III, Senior Systems Specialist, and Systems Specialist; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mountain View will compensate its employees portal to portal while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or prepositioned for emergency response; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mountain View will compensate its employees overtime while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or prepositioned for emergency response; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of Mountain View authorizes overtime and portal-to-portal pay for employees when staff are deployed to assist with wildland fires and other emergency incidents.
