A RESOLUTION AMENDING
THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW MASTER FEE SCHEDULE TO INCLUDE
ON-DEMAND MOBILE FUELING AND RELATED PERMITS,
PLAN REVIEW AND INSPECTION FEES
