Any person wishing to appeal this action must call and make an appointment with the City Clerk's office at (650) 903-6304. Please note that City Hall is closed to the general public at this time due to current restrictions. The City Hall parking garage at 500 Castro Street is open and will be used for the drop-off location for the appeal fee (\$50) and the appellant's note/letter for the reason or grounds of appeal. Follow the signage once you have made your appointment to the Building Plan Check Drop-off point in the garage at your scheduled time. Appeals must be scheduled and processed by **5:00 P.M., May 26, 2021**. This temporarily modifies Section 32.31 of the City of Mountain View Code slightly as to the location of payment and process due to Coronavirus and City Hall being closed to the general public until a time where City Hall is opened.

For further information regarding this Heritage Tree Removal Notice, contact the Forestry Division Office at (650) 903-6273. Please note that the city requires replanting when heritage trees are removed unless staff feels there is a reason to not require a replant such as number of existing trees on the property. After the posting period, if the tree is allowed to be removed, the owners will be sent a letter requesting a replant. Staff will follow up in a few months to see if the tree has been removed and if they have met their replant requirement if they were required to do so.
