**SUBJECT: Actions from the November 12, 2024 City Council Regular Meeting**

At the City Council Regular meeting on Tuesday, November 12, 2024, the following actions were taken:

- 4.1) Approved City Council meeting minutes of October 15, 2024
- 4.2) Found the proposed amendments to Chapter 8 (Buildings) of the Mountain View City Code to be exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), the common-sense exemption, as it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the changes adopted will have a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment or significant effect on the environment; and Section 15308 of the CEQA Guidelines as this ordinance is an action taken by a regulatory agency for the purpose of protecting the environment by reducing greenhouse gas emissions that are produced from buildings

Adopted Ordinance No. 8.2024 of the City Council of the City of Mountain View Adopting Required Findings, Amending Chapter 8 (Buildings) of the Mountain View City Code to Adopt Local Amendments to the 2022 Editions of the California Green Building Standards Code and the California Plumbing Code to Add Electrical Prewiring Requirements and to Make Clarifying Changes to Recycled Water Requirements, and Finding the Amendments to Be Exempt from Review Under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15061(b)(3) and 15308

- 4.3) Made available to the public the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Annual Compliance Report for Development Impact Fees and Capacity Charges; and Informational Reporting of Park Land Dedication Fees, and placed the reports on the agenda for the December 10, 2024 Council meeting
- 4.4) Adopted Resolution No. 18944 of the City Council of the City of Mountain View 1) Approving an Amended Community Health Awareness Council ("CHAC") Joint Powers Agreement, 2) Authorizing the City Manager to Execute the Amended CHAC Joint Powers Agreement, and 3) Authorizing the City Manager to Provide Written Consent to the CHAC Joint Powers Authority ("JPA") Board to Dissolve the CHAC JPA Once the City Receives Written Notice From the CHAC JPA Board that Wind Up of CHAC's Business Affairs has Concluded

Appointed Audrey Seymour Ramberg, Assistant City Manager, as the City's representative to the CHAC Joint Powers Authority Board

- 4.5) Authorized the City Manager or designee to approve and execute an agreement between the City of Mountain View and Sun Ridge Systems, Inc., for the purchase of Computer-Aided Dispatch Software, hardware, maintenance, and support services in conjunction with the cities of Palo Alto and Los Altos
