Upon the completion of a field inspection, Forestry Division staff has determined that the request to have the tree/trees removed be:

<u>CONDITION OF TREE / CONDITIONS AFFECTING THE TREE</u>: Tree has good branch structure and a healthy canopy. Root system does not appear to be impacting home or garage floor. Cracks in concrete slab of garage appear to be unrelated to the root system. Future pruning of tree will reduce the potential of limb drop. Does not meet ordinance criteria for removal.

Any person wishing to appeal this action must file an appeal (Fee \$50) with the City Clerk's Office, 500 Castro Street, Mountain View, CA. The office is open for drop-ins Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. It is recommended to call and make an appointment at (650) 903-6304. Appeals must be submitted by **5:00 p.m., November 18, 2024.**

HERITAGE TREE REMOVAL APPLICATION: 745 LOLA LANE

Dear Danyang,

Your request to remove one (1) Deodar Cedar Heritage tree has been denied after a field inspection and review by the Urban Forestry Division.

Your removal request is defined by the City Ordinance, Article I, in accordance with the Mountain View City Code, Article II, Section 32.35, Paragraph (1) which states:

 The condition of the tree with respect to age of the tree relative to the life span of that particular species, disease, infestation, general health, damage, public nuisance, danger of falling, proximity to existing or proposed structures, and interference with utility services.

Following the Forestry staff's inspection, it was observed that the heritage tree is healthy with no structural defects and does not fit the criteria for removal.

This decision has been posted on the property. Please refer to the analogod Haritage Tree Notice for an explanation of the appeal process.
