TITLE: **Landfill Gas Flare Replacement,
Project 14-52 – Accept Construction**

RECOMMENDATION

Accept Landfill Gas Flare Replacement, Project 14-52, and authorize the final contract payment.

BACKGROUND

On July 1, 2014, the City Council authorized the award of the construction contract for Landfill Gas Flare Replacement, Project 14-52. The contract was awarded to D.W. Nicholson Corporation of Hayward, California, at the low bid price of \$510,290, which included a \$68,000 construction contingency. The project replaced three existing landfill gas flares and other appurtenances at the end of their useful life.

ANALYSIS

The final construction cost of \$463,502 is within the construction budget of \$510,290 and includes one change order to install louver guards, extend air piping and electrical conduits, and install additional drain valves for \$21,212. All work has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications.

FISCAL IMPACT

Landfill Gas Flare Replacement, Project 14-52, is funded with \$1,208,000 from the Shoreline Regional Park Community Fund. The total project expenditure is approximately \$1,197,000. The remaining balance will be returned to the Shoreline Regional Park Community Fund when the project is closed.

ALTERNATIVE

Determine that the improvements have not been completed in conformance with City standards and decline to accept the improvements until they are completed to the satisfaction of the Council.
