TITLE: Appointment to the Youth Advisory

Committee for the 2022-23 School Year

Term

RECOMMENDATION

Appoint 15 members to the Youth Advisory Committee for the 2022-23 school year term and eight members-at-large/alternates to the Youth Advisory Committee for the 2022-23 school year term, as recommended by the Council Youth Services Committee.

BACKGROUND

On September 11, 2007, the City Council approved Resolution No. 17235, establishing the Youth Advisory Committee (YAC) to initiate increased civic involvement by youth in Mountain View. The resolution states that the YAC may consist of a maximum of 15 middle school and high school students and that members are to be selected through an application and interview process facilitated through the Community Services Department and Recreation Division and appointed by the City Council. The Recreation Division forwards its recommendations to the Council Youth Services Committee (CYSC) prior to formal appointment by the City Council. YAC members serve for one year and may serve six terms on the YAC.

In spring 2022, Recreation Division staff began YAC recruitment efforts for the 2022-23 school year, as described in Attachment 1. A total of 33 applications were received by the deadline. Applicants were interviewed by Recreation staff in April, and the appointment recommendations were forwarded to and approved by the CYSC on May 3, 2022.
