REASON FOR REMOVAL: Tree roots are damaging driveway and sidewalk hardscape. Over the time, the tree roots have pushed the driveway and sidewalk hardscape up which causes trip hazard.

This situation is expected to worsen with time. The trees are in a location which is in conflict with driveway and sidewalk hardscape improvement as part of planned construction project.

We don't want to spend lots of money to redo the driveway and sidewalk and then get damaged by the tree roots later in the future.


