Re: Appeal for heritage tree removal at 1783 Woodhaven Place

Dear Sir or Madam,

I am the owner of the house at 1783 Woodhaven Pl, an adjacent property to 611 Leksich Avenue. My previous request to have an oak tree in my backyard removed was recently denied by the Forestry Department.


The tree poses a significant threat to the structural integrity of part of our neighbors garage building. We routinely cut the branches of the tree since 2013 but the growth in the tree trunk has continued and has pushed back the fence line such that both the tree trunk and fence are now only seventeen inches from our neighbors garages. Within a few years, the tree trunk will be in direct contact with ~~our~~ garages and compromise the garages' physical integrity.

The tree could fall directly onto their garage and cause significant property damage and danger to our neighbors.

I'd like to appeal for the orderly and safe removal of the oak tree before it causes further damage in an uncontrolled and unpredictable way.
