### **RECOMMENDATION**

Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Mountain View Appointing Tina Pham to the Environmental Planning Commission, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 1 to Council report).

### **BACKGROUND**

On February 18, 2025, the City Council interviewed two applicants for one opening on the Environmental Planning Commission with an unexpired term ending December 31, 2025. The City Council made a recommendation for appointment as outlined in Attachment 1.

### **LEVINE ACT**

California Government Code Section 84308 (also known as the Levine Act) prohibits city officials from participating in any proceeding involving a "license, permit, or other entitlement for use" if the official has received a campaign contribution exceeding \$500 from a party, participant, or agent of a party or participant within the last 12 months. The Levine Act is intended to prevent financial influence on decisions that affect specific, identifiable persons or participants.
