TITLE: Adopt Amendments to City Code,

Chapter 38 (Second Reading)

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt an Ordinance Amending Chapter 38, Regulating the Use of City Parks and Other City Facilities, to Add Article IV, Regulating the Use of City Trails. (First reading: 7-0)

SUMMARY

On June 9, 2015, the City Council approved proposed amendments to Chapter 38 of the Mountain View City Code Relating to Regulating the Use of City Parks and Other City Facilities.

This is the second reading of the Ordinance for the approval of proposed amendments, which is required by the City Charter. If approved, amendments to Chapter 38 will become effective on August 1, 2015.

FISCAL IMPACT

The cost of new signage and public outreach is estimated at \$2,000. The cost to enhance the volunteer program is anticipated to be minimal, as current staffing resources will be reprioritized to focus on this program. Ranger hours on the trail will be increased by reallocating existing contract hours. Based on the first-year trial program, long-term Ranger costs will be evaluated. These costs will be absorbed in the Community Services Department's budget for the trial period. The cost of any use of Police Department personnel for enforcement is unknown at this time.

PUBLIC NOTICING

In addition to the standard agenda posting, signs advertising the meeting have been posted along the City trail system. Also, the Friends of Stevens Creek Trail, Silicon Valley Bicycle Coalition, and interested individuals have been notified via e-mail.
