6.1 Adult Literacy Services, presented by Librarian Mark Jack

Library Director, Tracy Gray shared updates on the current programs and events in the library including Silicon Valley Reads programs, teen events and programs, the children's Doodle and Discover program, and the Free Tax preparation program.
