Aggregate Information	Can send aggregate information		Same as SB 31
Enforcement	N/A		Authorizes enforcement for alleged violation of ordinance; police report regarding compliance with ordinance annually; civil action holding city liable for violations including damages and penalties and prevailing part attorney fees – civil action subject to presentation of a claim within three years of violation
