A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THEIR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH EVENERGI FOR THE INSTALLATION OF FOUR ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING PORTS AT 1000 VILLA STREET FOR CITY FLEET VEHICLE USE FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$48,153, AND FINDING THAT THE PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2025, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18993, which adopted the Greenhouse Gas-Free Fleet and Landscaping Equipment Purchasing Policy ("Policy"); and

WHEREAS, the Policy prioritizes the purchase of electric on-road and off-road vehicles as a first option instead of fossil fuel vehicles; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the Policy, the City of Mountain View ("City") has purchased electric vehicles for its fleet that are expected to arrive by the end of 2025; and

WHEREAS, the installation of electric vehicle ("EV") charging infrastructure at City facilities is necessary to support the City's electric vehicles; and

WHEREAS, EVenergi, an EV charger management provider, was awarded grant funds through a California Energy Commission program, the Responsive, Easy Charging Products with Dynamic Signals (REDWDS) Grant program, for the development and deployment of EV charging infrastructure and products that manage EV charging and respond to dynamic grid signals; and

WHEREAS, EVenergi is able to use \$100,000 in REDWDS grant funds to help provide the City with EV chargers and charging optimization software; and

WHEREAS, the City's contribution to obtain and install these EV chargers through EVenergi would be \$48,153; and

WHEREAS, EVenergi and the City desire to collaborate on the installation of EV chargers and sharing of charger data to help develop charging optimization software; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of Mountain View authorizes the City Manager or their designee to enter into an agreement with EVenergi for the installation of four electric vehicle charging ports at 1000 Villa Street for City fleet vehicle use for a total

amount not to exceed Forty Eight Thousand One Hundred Fifty Three dollars (\$48,153); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of Mountain View does hereby find that the Project is categorically exempt as Class 3, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures, under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15303 and on a separate and independent basis is categorically exempt as Class 1, Existing Facilities, under the CEQA Guidelines Section 15301; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Resolution shall be effective upon the date of its adoption.
