2. Adopt a Resolution Prohibiting the Operation of a Bicycle, Electric Bicycle, or Transportation Device upon Sidewalks in Designated Locations, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 2 to the Council report).

Following discussion, Councilmember Clark modified the motion to allow riders of ten years old and younger on the sidewalk; and added two amendments recommended by the Mountain View Coalition for Sustainable Planning, modifying the following section titles as shown below to be complete and better align across the sections:

- 1) Section 19.54 Operating Motorized Scooters and Transportation Devices on Roadways; and
- 2) Section 19.57 Parking Spaces for Bicycles, Electric Bicycles, Motorized Scooters, and Transportation Devices; and to keep ordering consistent, put "motorized scooters" before "transportation devices" in the following: Section 19.57 Bicycle Parking Spaces; when official signs or markings restricting parking to bicycles are in place, no person shall park or stand any vehicle other than a bicycle, electric bicycle, transportation device or motorized scooter in such a space.
