Re: Trip Cap Reports

The Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 Trip Cap Reports are useful for judging the effects of the pandemic. They will serve as baselines for the recovery phase when sufficient data is available. It obviously was not available as of February 2022, since Google's hybrid work schedule did not take effect till early April. Too much has changed for pre-April data to be used to forecast the future. The same could be said for the North Bayshore Precise Plan, which was antiquated even before the pandemic.

Council need not wait till the Fall 2022 report for a peek at what the present looks like. Attached are my personal counts of northbound vehicles at the Shoreline/Avenida/101/85 intersection during 15-20 minute intervals of the morning peak hour between late April and early June. Early April counts are excluded due to the signal control system having been disrupted by a construction incident, which may have caused anomalies. Later counts were not taken because I was sick and tired of doing them. The most significant findings were as follows:

- (1) Total midweek northbound (incoming) vehicle traffic decreased by 12% from pre-pandemic levels. Monday and Friday traffic was only half as great as Tuesday through Thursday.
- (2) Midweek traffic northbound on Shoreline Boulevard decreased by over 35%. Shoreline is free of congestion from Middlefield to Avenida.
- (3) Inbound traffic on the 85/101N exit increased by more than 10% relative to 2019, but with less congestion, as evidenced by shorter queue lengths on the exit ramp, rarely extending past the merge point. This was made possible by there being fewer backups from the Pear Avenue intersection once the signal control damage was repaired. Two factors may have contributed to the shift from Shoreline to freeways -- (a) virtual elimination of 101 drivers turning south, making a U-turn at Terra Bella, and approaching North Bayshore on Shoreline, and (b) Google employees having moved from the overpriced and overcrowded vicinity of Mountain View to more family-friendly locations farther away.
- (4) A majority of northbound shuttle buses come from the freeway exit rather than Shoreline, and obviously not from the downtown Transit Center. Even in the AM peak, southbound shuttles outnumber northbound 2:1. Rengstorff and San Antonio are still the way in and Shoreline the way out for many shuttles. VTA is irrelevant.

Doing the so-called Spring Trip Cap in February leads to low counts of cyclists and pedestrians. Most of them get to North Bayshore on the Permanente and Stevens Creek Trails. The trails close at dusk, which comes before quitting time in winter. Pedestrians will be undercounted at any time of year if the counting device is a pneumatic tube laid in their path. Most walkers will step over it. Only the occasional fanatic will stomp on it several times to make sure his peers are not overlooked.
