Status Update - Work Plan

- Identify data needs, information sources and community contacts Complete
- Reach out to community contacts and gather data Complete
- Monitor development of TRUST, MCRT and MVPD BSU programs In progress; ongoing
- Compile information to develop an informal Mountain View "community profile" to help inform County and MVPD programs – Complete
- Partner with County and TRUST/MCRT providers to share information with the community and promote awareness of these new/expanded programs - In progress; ongoing
- Seek community feedback about TRUST and MCRT and share with the County In progress; ongoing
- Bring updates and recommendations to the PSAB In progress; ongoing

Recent Efforts



- TRUST launched in late Fall 2022
- TRUST Assistant Manager joined the monthly community-based organization (CBO) meeting
- City staff presented Mountain View "community profile" to Momentum for Health/TRUST and provided key next steps
- Continued staff meetings with County Behavioral Health re: 988 crisis line, MCRT, etc.

TRUST Call Center: Team dispatched by the TRUST Call Center, which is run by Pacific Clinics.

Field Work: Team was out in the community and happened to encounter someone needing assistance.

Follow-up: Team checking on someone they recently served through either the TRUST Call Center or Field Work. This is often done the next day.



Federal Earmark Augmentation

Background:

- Cities of Palo Alto, Mountain View, and Los Altos
- \$2.2m through Congresswoman Eshoo
- Alternative mental health response (non-law enforcement)

Proposal:

- Augment No. County TRUST/Trust
- 8 promotores/as to build TRUST's network with nonprofits, community groups, etc.
- Extra outreach staffing
- Extra case management staffing



- Update data in community profile
 - MVPD calls with indication of behavioral health issues
 - MVPD OD calls
 - OD deaths
 - Deaths by suicide
- Continue networking with Momentum for Health to support building community awareness of TRUST
- Continue gathering TRUST encounter data
- Continue staff meetings with County Behavioral Health re: 988 crisis line, MCRT, etc.
