I ask for your support for the **Item 4.2** coming before you on Tuesday, April 25 on the consent calendar on a resolution to protect Juristac and oppose the gravel quarry at Sargent Ranch. The DEIR for this open pit mining operation proposed by the Debt Acquisition Company of America DACA states that this proposed project would irrevocably degrade lands held as sacred by the Amah Mutsun Tribal Band as well as sever one of the few remaining vital wildlife corridors connecting the coastal ranges with interior mountains of the Diablo Range.
