Subject: Crossing at Grant Road & Sleeper Avenue

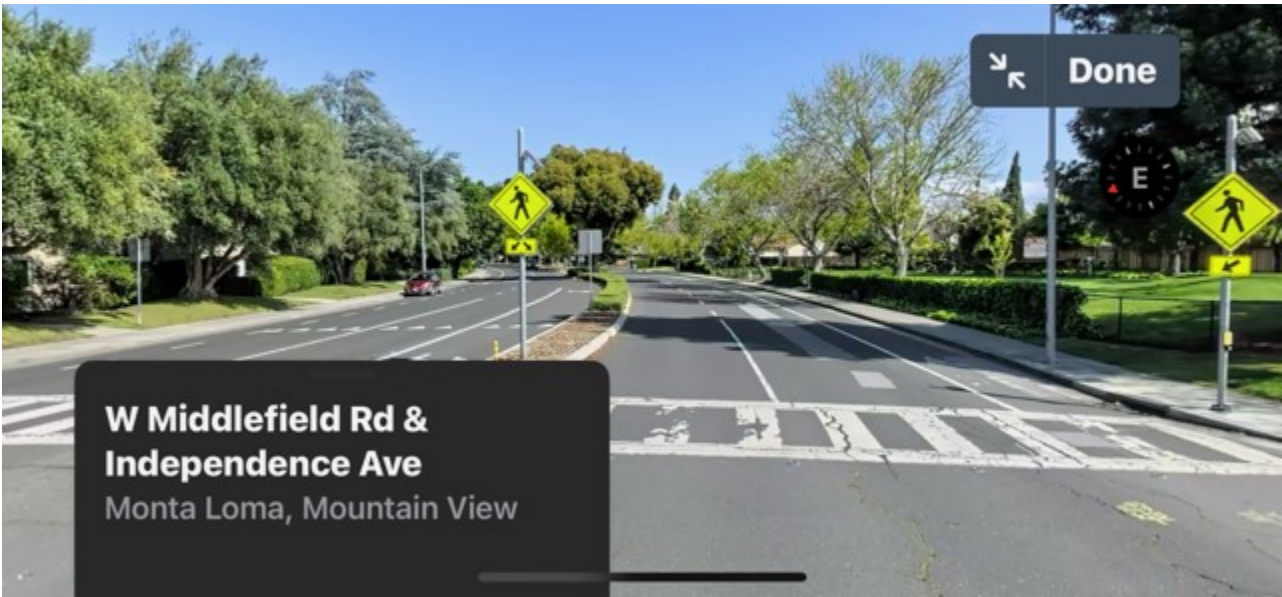

Greetings All -

I am very disappointed to learn that Item 4.4 on the upcoming consent calendar “Grant Road & Sleeper Avenue Intersection Project” may be pulled and scuttled after years of discussion and public input, professional design/engineering and an already awarded contract with money already spent on pilot holes for light standards and no heads up to the hundreds of users of this dangerous existing crossing thoughtlessly put together by now retired Mike Fuller of the Public Works Department. If Council is planning to cancel this project due to costs then I offer two alternatives: restructure the existing crossing with a simplified design such as that at Independence & W. Middlefield (See attached pic) or shut down the current crossing, remove the yellow dot pads on both sides of Grant Road, the mid crossing safety zone and place crossing barriers with signs directing pedestrians to the nearby intersections. Don’t leave it as is due to the dangerous conditions of pedestrians versus fast moving vehicles in an unmarked crossing.
